## DeLorean car to be priced at \$10,500

DETROIT — (AP) — A new gull-wing sports coupe being developed by De Lorean Motor Co. will go into production in less than two years, according to the trade journal automotive News.

The DMC-12 has a first-year production schedule of about 20,000 units, the weekly said. Target price for the auto is about \$10,500.

The car has a wheelbase of 97.2 inches, just under the 98-inch wheelbase of the 1976 Chevrolet Corvette. The DMC-12 is 165.1 inches long, 72.7 inches wide and 46 inches high. It weighs 2,200 pounds.

The auto, with an exterior by Giugiaro of Italy design, is powered by a turbo-charged, transversely mounted V-6 engine built by the Ford Motor Co.

The four-wheel independent suspension was designed with a computer program. Four-wheel disc brakes are standard.

The DMC-12, built by firm owner and former General Motors Corp. executive John Z. De Lorean, boasts of driver-and-passenger survival in an 80-to-100-mile-per-hour head-on collision.

Automotive News reported that a prototype DMC-12 is getting fuel mileage of 20 miles per gallon on the Environmental Protection Agency city cycle and 30 miles a gallon on the highway test.
